- The deadline for the submission of proposals, by hand, to SAFE’s main office in Gaza is **05/07/2026** at 12:00 PM (Gaza time).
- Bidders will be required to sign and submit the Bid Securing Declaration and all mandatory declarations and forms as specified in the RFP documents.
- **SAFE is not bound** to award the contract to the lowest-priced offer and reserves the right to accept the whole or part of any proposal, reject any or all proposals, cancel the process, or re-announce where this is in the best interest of the project and beneficiaries.
- The awarded company shall bear the costs of advertisements published in newspapers and other platforms used for announcing this RFP.
